Pennsylvania judge; wrote account of 1775 march to Quebec (1812)

Detroit physician.

Wrote memoir/lineage (1908) of Stephen Chambers Henry

Chief engineer of Detroit Waterworks (1872-1877)

Federalist Representative in Congress (1815-1817)

Philadelphia lawyer; edited (1876) g-father's account of Quebec march

St. Louis physician.
