Weekend Policy for Reenactors & Vehicles

REGISTRATION

- All groups and individuals wishing to participate in event activities must Pre-register by US Mail or email john.uhler@rcn.com by August 15, 2020. NO WALK ON'S THE DAY OF THE EVENT.
- All Reenactors must be listed as a PARTICIPANT OF A PRE-REGISTERED REENACTMENT GROUP processed and approved by Event Coordinators.
- All Reenactor groups and individual registrations will be reviewed and approved by the Event Coordinators.
- Please fill in the attached Reenactor Registration form which must be emailed to john.uhler@rcn.com or mailed to Jacobsburg Historical Society, Attention: WWII Event Coordinator, PO Box 345, Nazareth PA 18064 by **August 15, 2020**.
- This is a two day event (Saturday, October 3 & Sunday, October 4). We appreciate and encourage all groups and group members to stay for the FULL TWO DAY EVENT. This is a Rain or Shine event!! There will be No Rain Date.
- All registered reenactors must be in their period uniform/period clothing for entry on Saturday and Sunday during the public hours of the event.
- Each registered reenactor will receive a participant event program. The participant event program will have the list of events for the day, information about the Boulton Historic Site and Jacobsburg Historical Society, including event rules and regulations.

REENACTMENT BATTLE

Jacobsburg Historical Society is requiring all reenactment groups or units to have insurance to participate in the REENACTMENT BATTLE ONLY. Each group participating in the battle will need to produce a certificate of insurance to the event coordinators upon arrival/check-in. If you do not have insurance, you may be able to join another unit to go under their insurance. If you are a Living History Group only with displays we will not require insurance. All reenactors will receive a standard wristband at registration. All those participating in the Reenactment Battle will be given an additional "battle only" wristband.

- ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THE BATTLE MUST BE WEARING THEIR PROPERLY SECURED "BATTLE ONLY" WRISTBANDS FOR ENTRANCE TO THE BATTLE. If you DO NOT have the special "battle only" wristband while on the battlefield you will be asked to leave the field.
- We will have Safety Officers /Weapon Inspectors. All weapons & ammo must be inspected by the Safety Officers.
- All firing of weapons must be during scheduled program events or by special permission of the Safety Officers.
- NO LIVE AMMO ON SITE
- No hand to hand combat, No mock executions, No fixed bayonets or unsheathed bayonets/ knives. Do not point the muzzle directly at another reenactor or their vehicles.
- All reenactors in the battle will police the field after the engagement is finished. That means no one leaves the field until all the brass is picked up.

Arrival / Set-up / Breakdown

- Enter via the main entrance to the Boulton Historic Site off Schoeneck Road (a large sign is at the entrance of the driveway). This is the same entrance that all the spectators and guests will be using.
- Registration will open 12:00 pm Friday and close 8:45 am Saturday Morning. **YOU MUST REGISTER BY 8:45 am** or you will not be allowed to participate for the weekend. If you cannot make the registration cut off time please contact us, so we can check you in for the weekend.
- When you arrive, please check in, and have ammunition/weapons checked. (Location will be clearly marked.) You will receive your information, and your setup location for the weekend.
- Set up – Friday: 12:00 pm – 8:00pm (contact us if you need to come earlier or later). Saturday and Sunday: 6:30 am – 8:45 am (all personal vehicles out of the show area by 8:30 am).
- Breakdown Saturday if needed – 5:30 pm. Breakdown Sunday – 3:00 pm
- Free Reenactor Breakfast Buffet – Sunday 7:30am (tickets available at registration).

Camping

- All groups are welcome to camp on site Friday evening through Sunday afternoon.
- Firewood and porta-pots will be available all weekend
- Digging fox-holes or fire pits will be allowed, but must be approved by the event coordinators. Campfires are allowed, but cannot be left unattended. Please have a 3 gallon bucket of water nearby. Fox holes will be allowed in and along the tree line as approved.
- Please respect the historic buildings and grounds.
- Please be respectful of our neighbors and other campers with quiet by 10 pm.
- You will be responsible for cleaning up your camp site, making sure campfires are out with water, fill in fox holes, fire pits and replace sod.

Vehicle Parking

- Parking is on site, not far from the WWII reenactment area. If you need to unload, please follow the drive way toward the field and you will be directed to your area. If you do not need to unload, just park in the field that is marked Reenactor/Participant parking.

IMPORTANT NOTE to all reenactors, vehicle owners and living historians: If you are disrespectful to the event staff, public, veterans, site property, or to each other do not expect to be invited back next year. If you register for the event and you do not show up without letting us know, do not expect to be invited back next year.

Please understand that the event coordinators have the right to remove you off the property (via the Bushkill Township Police Department) for not complying with site and event rules at Any Time for Any Reason.
