Build a Pennsylvania Longrifle **Gunsmith Apprentice Program**

- During this 9 week program, the apprentice should acquire the basic knowledge needed to build a basic Pennsylvania Longrifle.
- The class will consist of approximately 40 hours of instruction in building a longrifle under the direction of Rocky Schreck.
- Pre-carved stocks still require a great deal of work to complete, but will greatly reduce the chance of "Apprentice Apprehension Syndrome."
- Basic parts are supplied by JHS and are included in the course fee.
- Please give us advanced notice if you are a left-handed shooter.
- All students should have a working knowledge of basic hand tools as well as a set of basic tools of the trade. The following is a minimum list of tools which students may augment as they please:
