Social Distancing: We ask guests to maintain 6-feet of social distancing while visiting our site. Signs will assist with this effort.

Face Coverings: Guests and volunteer staff will be required to wear face coverings when indoors as well as outdoors when social distancing cannot be maintained. Signs will assist with this effort.

Hand Sanitizer: We will have hand sanitizer available before entering our museums and gift shop as well as signage promoting proper hygiene.

Enhanced Cleaning: Our museum volunteers will frequently wipe commonly touched surfaces throughout the day with disinfecting wipes.

Portable Toilets: Handicap accessible portable toilets will be available for public use at the main parking gate and near the Pennsylvania Longrifle Museum during our open weekends.

Museum Group Tours: Guests will be permitted to enter in small groups at approximate 15-minute intervals. This will enable groups to be spaced out throughout the museums and the gift shop to reduce capacity. Groups of more than 5 will be divided (except where there are small children).
