The Pennsylvania Longrifle Museum is located in the Henry Homestead; 403 Henry Road, Nazareth PA.

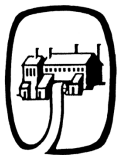
The John Joseph Henry House and grounds, including the Nicholas Hawk Gun Shop, are located at 402 Henry Road.

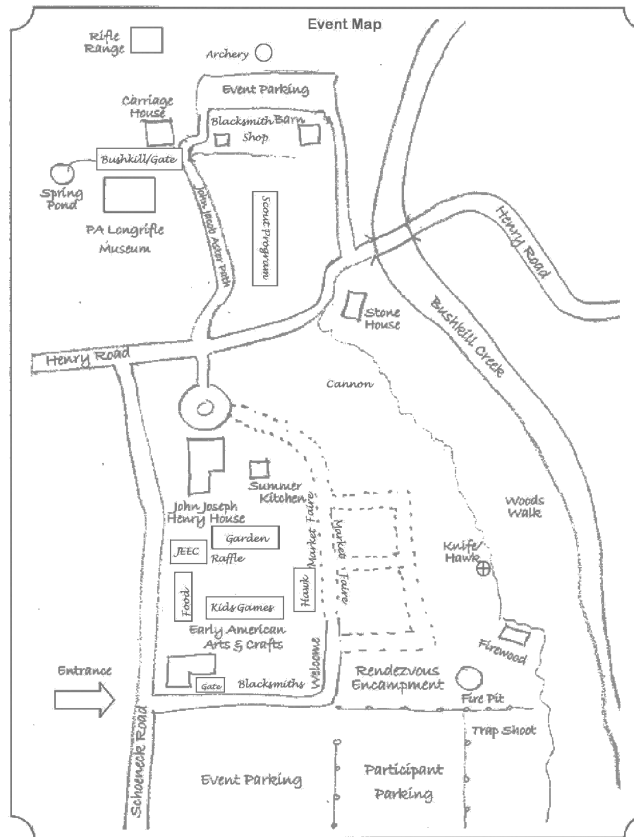

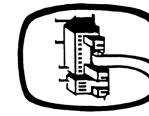
