Agreement between Matthew
L. Henry Joseph &
William Henry

Know all Men by these presents, that whereas
the heirs and legates of William Henry esquire
late of the City of Philadelphia dec'd bound by a certain
Instrument of writing agreed to deduct and
allow to a Messrs. of Henry, Jun^r for Henry, Will^m
Henry & Jun^r Moore (they being purchasers of
real property of said William Henry dec'd) there-
to five per cent on the original cost of the
purchase & whereas said Messrs. of Henry will be
considerably benefitted by said arrangement &
Jun^r for Henry & William Henry will be the
losers it is therefore agreed that Messrs. of
Henry do pay and indemnify said Jun^r for Henry
and William for any loss they might sustain
in consequence of such arrangement, which
said loss Messrs. of Henry provide to pay to them
at such times whenever they are to pay their
Bonds due by them to the Estate of said William
Henry deceased. Witness my hand this Day
