Letters Testamentary  
William Fredric Sautter of  
Bethlehem  
Northampton County.

In the Name of God! Amen!

I William Fredric Sautter at present on a visit at Pottelcherry in the County of Northampton and State of Pennsylvania; being well in Health, and of sound mind, Memory, and Understanding, praised be God for the same; do make this my last will and Testament in Manner and Form following: First I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Maria the Use of the Rest and Residue of my Estate - during her Natural Life, and in Case the Interest of the Monies should prove insufficient for her Maintenance, she shall have the Liberty to take and use so much of the Principle Sum as may be required for that Purpose. - And after her Decease I give and bequeath the then Remainder to my four Children: Amelia Wilhelmine, Justine Elisabeth, Mary Magdalene; and Louisa Christiane in equal Shares, and if either of my Children should thro' Sickness come into want, I then will that such Child shall be assisted out of my Estate after my Wifes Decease, such Child shall not be charged therewith. And I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my trusty Friend Henry Schulz, and my dear Brother in Law George Schuster the Executors of this my

last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and making void  
all and every other Will and Wills at any time heretofore by  
me made, and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament.  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal  
the fifteenth Day of April, in the Year of our Lord,  
One thousand Eight hundred and Nineteen.
